## Notice Regarding Changes to New York State Election Law Affecting Certain New York City Filers

As a result of the passage of A1740/S3134, signed into law by Governor Cuomo as Chapter 465 of the Laws of 2019 on November 8, 2019 promulgating a new Election Law §14-105, and following a finding by the Commissioners of the New York State Board of Elections on April 27, 2020 that the New York City Campaign Finance Board (NYCCFB) meets the criteria set forth in Election Law §14-105, certain New York City filers should be aware of changes to the requirements for registration and filing of campaign finance disclosures, as follows:

- Candidates running for certain New York City offices, namely City Council, Mayor, Public Advocate, Comptroller and Borough President, shall register and file all campaign finance disclosures solely with the NYCCFB. Election Law §14-105(1).
- So long as candidates for such offices have filed with the NYCCFB, such filings will satisfy the requirement to register and file with the New York State Board of Elections (NYSBOE). Election Law §14-105(1).
- Candidates for other offices are not affected and shall continue to register and file with NYSBOE.
- Applies to all registrations and filings made on or after April 27, 2020.
