

## Voting Options for the 2020 General Election

New York State Law provides three options to registered voters to vote in the 2020 general election. The three options are:

- Vote during the early voting period. The early voting period will start on October 24<sup>th</sup> and will end on November 1st. To find where you can vote early, go to <https://voterlookup.elections.ny.gov/>
- Vote on election day, November 3, 2020. Poll sites are open statewide from 6 am to 9 pm. To find your election day poll site, go to <https://voterlookup.elections.ny.gov/>
- Vote by absentee ballot. Voters may request an absentee ballot using our online portal (link here), by email, phone, mail, in-person or fax. Please visit: <https://www.elections.ny.gov/VotingAbsentee.html> for more information on how to apply and return an absentee ballot.

All early voting sites and poll sites will implement safety protocols to address COVID-19. Please wear a mask, expect to social distance at the site, and use hand sanitizer. Sites will be routinely disinfected.
