ABSENTEE BALLOT DEADLINES NEAR FOR GENERAL ELECTION

ALBANY, NY -- (10/18/00) -- The State Board of Elections today reminded all New Yorkers that if they will be out of their county or New York City on Election Day, or will be unable to go to the polls because of illness or physical disability, they may vote by absentee ballot.

Voters will receive an absentee ballot after they complete an application and mail it to their county board of elections no later than Tuesday, October 31, or hand deliver it by Monday, November 6. All completed absentee ballots must be postmarked by Monday, November 6, and received no later than Tuesday, November 14, at your county board of elections. Absentee ballots may also be hand delivered to your county board by Tuesday, November 7, Election Day.
